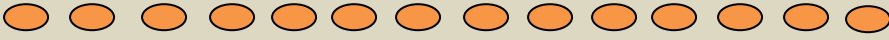


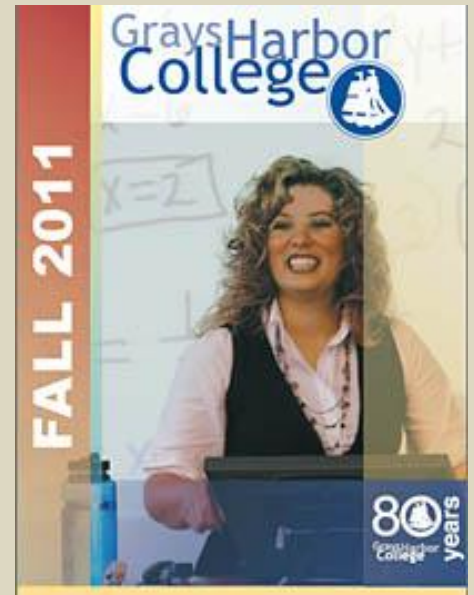
Class Registration

How do new students register for classes?

Entering students register for classes by attending an Entry Advising session. These are group sessions held throughout the summer and before the start of each quarter. At these sessions students complete a New Student Orientation, meet with an advisor who helps them select their classes, get assigned a permanent advisor, and meet with a payment consultant.

Students can sign up for Entry Advising by calling the Counseling and Advising Center at 360-538-4099. Students need to have taken the College Placement Test <http://www.ghc.edu/counseling/cpt.htm> before the Entry Advising session.

How do current students register for classes?

Current students who have 24 or more completed credits (already on their transcript) can register online by using their global pin number and their student ID. We recommend that students do a degree audit to help with course selection and review their selections with their advisor prior to registration. Students who are nearing graduation are especially encouraged to review a degree audit with an advisor.

Students with 23 or fewer credits must see their advisor for help in course selection and get a quarterly registration pin number which they can use along with their student ID to register for classes on the GHC website at <https://www.ctc.edu/~grays/webreg/waci221.html>.
