

# PINs and Student ID Numbers



Grays Harbor College uses three student numbers in the advising and registration process:

## **Student Identification Number (SID) (permanent)**

Replaces social security number. Your Student I.D. is assigned and mailed to you by Admissions & Records (A&R) in the 100 Building (538-4026). If you have forgotten your Student I.D. or have lost it, contact A&R to have it reissued. You can also look up your SID through the Student Information Kiosk on the web.

You can obtain your first photo SID card free of charge from the bookstore (Please bring a photo I.D.)

## **Global PIN (permanent)**

This is a six-digit number that is randomly assigned by A&R and mailed to you as a new student. Use your Global PIN, along with your SID, to access the following information about yourself under the Records menu on the College website.

- Grades
- Degree Audit
- Your /class Schedule (“Student Schedule”)
- Unofficial Transcript
- Financial Aid Status

Students with 24 or more credits also use this PIN to register for classes.

## **Registration PIN (changes each quarter)**

This is a randomly assigned six-digit number *assigned by A&R and given to **academic advisors only*** at the start of each quarter. If you have earned 23 or fewer classes, you must use your Registration PIN plus your SID in order to web-register for classes. You must obtain your Registration PIN from your advisor
