After successfully completing the Accounting requirements, students will:

1. Possess the skills needed to secure entry-level employment in the accounting department of a variety of business and non-business organizations.
2. Perform basic accounting functions, such as complete steps in the accounting cycle, prepare financial statements, or document transactions.
3. Analyze individual components of financial statements.
4. Use accounting information to make informed decisions about the operating performance, financial position, and tax liability of a company.
5. Use accounting software.
6. Demonstrate understanding of terminology related to accounting.
7. Identify and use appropriate resources for problem solving.
8. Receive, interpret, and follow both written and verbal instructions.
9. Interact effectively with individuals and groups.
10. Be aware of ethical issues impacting accountants.
11. Demonstrate knowledge of activities found in most organizations, such as marketing or management.
