



During the past years Grays Harbor College forensic teams, ably guided by Mr. Hillier, have consistently garnered regional and national honors. This year's team, participating in five tournaments, excelled in many events.

At the Pacific Lutheran College meet in November, Ron Roberts placed first in oratory, second in extemporaneous speaking, and second in interpretative reading. Alan Tinnerstet and Ron Roberts were first in debate at both Seattle Pacific in January and College of Puget Sound in February. Tinnerstet placed second in oratory at Seattle Pacific. Andy Carlson reached the finals in impromptu speaking at Linfield College in March.

This year the National Junior College Tournament was held at Grays Harbor College. Karmen Jarvela and Gail Newcomb won a tie for fourth place in the women's division debate. Ron Roberts won a national championship in extemporaneous speaking, and he and John Hogan tied for a third place trophy in men's oratory. Andy Carlson won a third place in interpretative speaking.
