ADMISSIONS POLICY

1. In accordance with WAC 131-12-010, any applicant for admission to Grays Harbor College shall be admitted when, as determined by the president or his/her designee, such applicant:
 - A. Is competent to profit from the curricular offerings of the college; and
 - B. would not, by his or her conduct, create a disruptive atmosphere within the college inconsistent with the purposes of the institution; and
 - C. is eighteen years of age or older; or
 - D. is a high school graduate, or the equivalent; or
 - E. has qualified for admission under the provisions of the Running Start student enrollment options program.
 - F. In cases of additional or new programs for students under age eighteen, faculty will be consulted in advance of the implementation.
 - G. Exceptions may be made by the Vice President for Student Services or his or her designee.
