## Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) Report

Report on Athletic Program Participation Rates and financial Support Data July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017

#### **Institution Enrollment**

The total Enrollment of Full-Time Undergraduates is 1,010 students. 54% are Female students (535) and 46% are Male students (475).

#### Athletic Student Aid & Recruiting

The total amount of Athletically Related Student Aid for all of our teams combined was \$184,337. Of that amount \$85,808 or 47% was awarded to our men's teams and \$98,529 or 53% was awarded to our women's teams.

Total expenses for recruiting was \$7,737. \$5,953 spent on the women's teams and \$1,784 on the men's teams.

## **Athletic Participation**

Our teams had a total of 160 participants. 89 competed for the men's teams (56%), and 71 for the women's teams (44%). We had 2 female athletes that competed in two sports. Our unduplicated count is 89 men, and 69 women.

#### **Total Revenues & Expenses**

Athletics generated a total of \$864,077 in Revenue. \$194,328 was not allocated by Gender/Sport. The teams generated the following amounts:

## **Operating (Game Day) Expenses**

Operating Expenses totaled \$365,334. Men's Team attributed \$190,153, and the Women's teams \$175,181. Below is the breakdown of each sport

## Average Coach Salaries

The average institutional Salary per Head Coaches for Men's teams is \$5607. 4 coaches were used to calculate this average. The average institutional salary for Head Coaches for Women's Teams is \$5607. 6 coaches were used to calculate this average.

The Average Annual Institutional Salary per Full Time Equivalent (FTE) for the Men's Head Coaches is \$26,079 with the sum of FTE Positions used to calculate the average 0.86. Women's Head Coaches Average Institutional Salary per Full-Time equivalent is \$26,283, with the sum of FTE positions used to calculate the average 1.28.

The Average Institutional Salary per assistant Coaches for Men and Women's programs is \$3,252. 4 men's positions were used for the calculations, and 6 women's positions were used. The men had 3 volunteer coaches, the women had 1 volunteer coach.

The Average Institutional Salary per full time equivalent for the men was \$26,016, with sum of FTE positions used to calculate the average being 0.50. The Average Institutional Salary for the women's programs was \$26,368, with a sum of FTE positions used to calculate the average 0.74
