Grays Harbor College was established in 1930 as a public, community college. Grays Harbor College strives to provide education of the highest quality. Our mission is to provide meaningful education and cultural enrichment through academic transfer, workforce preparation, basic skills, and service to community.

We admit international students in our college credit program only. If you have a TOEFL iBT score of more than 61 or an APIEL score of 3, 4, or 5, you meet the English proficiency requirements for the credit program.

We require you to provide the following documents:

- 1. Send a completed Grays Harbor College Admission Application and Supplemental Information Form. The Grays Harbor College Admission Application is available online at <u>http://www.ghc.edu</u>.
- 2. Provide translated copies of all scholastic records (i.e. secondary school, previous college, etc.). College records must be evaluated by an evaluation service from the list available at: http://www.naces.org/members.html
- 3. Submit a financial responsibility statement with original supporting documents from a financial institution. Estimated expenses for a school year (nine months) at our college are approximately US\$25,086.50.
- 4. Furnish proof of English proficiency (a copy of your TOEFL or APIEL score).

As an international student, you will be required to show proof of insurance for each quarter you are in attendance at Grays Harbor College.

International students at our college live in our surrounding community. The Aberdeen community has listed nearby apartment complexes and houses available for rent. Grays Harbor Transit has an extensive bus route system designed to help with any transportation needs you may have at a very affordable price.
