RS students are required to test into College Level Reading

- College level in all areas: Reading, ENGL& 101, and MATH& 107+
- CL Reading, ENGL&101, and MATH 97 (*cannot take math @ GHC*)
- CL Reading, ENGL 095, MATH& 107+ (*cannot take liberal arts @ GHC, can take math and science*)
- Vocational courses only; check prerequisites for vocational program
