NEW BUSINESS

The Club Banquet hosted by Student Life is on June 12th at 5:30 p.m. RSVP and Award Nomination's are due on June 8th at 5:00 p.m. Responsibilities and Bylaws will be talked about at the next meeting when we have Bylaw reviews. Ingrid has volunteered to make a Thank You Card for IGA for providing the food for the Induction Ceremony and present it to the meeting on Monday. Scott has agreed to find a time to meet with Dr. Minkler to go over this years goals with the College Project. Nichole mentioned she would like to put an emphasis on getting more members to five star status and Scott talked about the five star competitive edge program. The officer training date will be tabled until the next meeting. Scholarship for membership requirements still need to be talked about and it was mentioned that we should find out from Aaron Tuttle what the bare minimums are that college requires. Ralph stated that if we create less rules the better and that Officers should use their best judgement when choosing members. Steven stated there is still about \$1200 in the current budget before the Induction Ceremony food. Out of this budget \$300 was spent on food for Induction, and \$510 was allocated to go towards Registration fees for Summer Comference. Two members showed up to the meeting interested in our vacant officer position. After hearing there story of why they want to be our Public Relations Officer, a vote was held. Final decision was that Leroy Rowe would be our Public Relations Officer.
