This contest is open to all Grays Harbor College students enrolled in the 2017-18 academic year.

All art entries must be accompanied by a completed Entry Form. Please do not fold artwork or use staples.

We recommend labeling artwork with a legible artist name and title, however keep in mind that the artwork will be scanned, so labeling should not bleed through a thin area of the piece.

All entries must be received by 4:00 PM on May 31st, 2018.

Submissions should be turned in to Student Life, in the HUB.

Original artwork **must** be submitted. It is GHC's intention that original artwork will be returned after it has been scanned and the winners have been selected.

Entry content should be acceptable to an all-ages audience.

One entry per person, please.

Artwork

Artwork must be student's original work. Submitted artwork should be 8.5" by 11" in size. The work should be oriented vertically on the page (portrait).

Artwork chosen for inclusion in the Year Seven report will be presented underneath the Chapter Header Page Overlay. This template will cover parts of your image. Please make sure that essential parts of your submission are not cut off by the template. The template is available from the contest webpage at http://www.ghc.edu/art-contest.

Entries may be almost any form of 2-dimensional media (e.g. painting, sketch, photography, digital photography, etc.). Due to potential copyright issues we cannot accept a collage using materials from magazines, newspapers, or other printed sources. A collage made from neutral sources such as craft paper and fabric would be okay. Such a piece should be reasonably 2-dimensional.

Entries should follow the theme of *Scenes from Campus*. We would expect *Scenes from Campus* to potentially include images of GHC architecture, nature, students, classrooms, etc. Further interpretation of the theme is up to you, so use your imagination!
