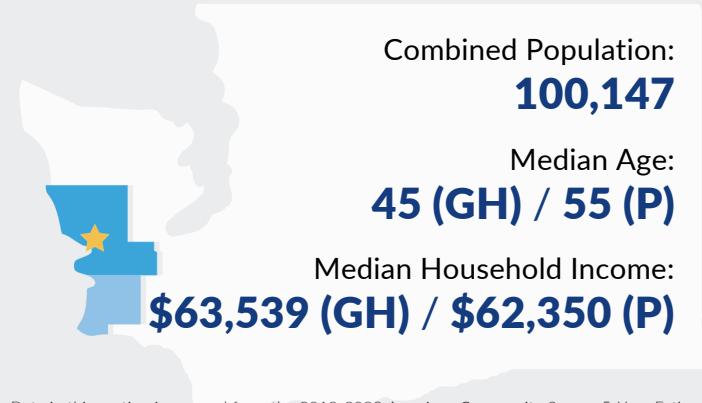

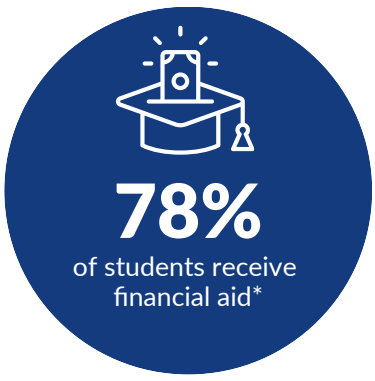

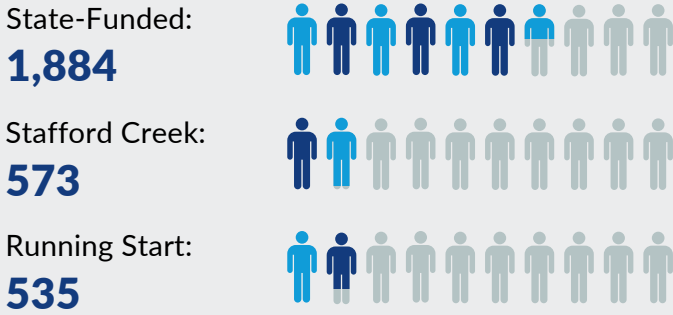

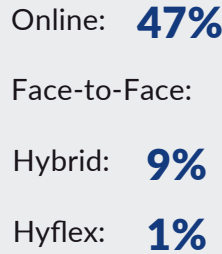

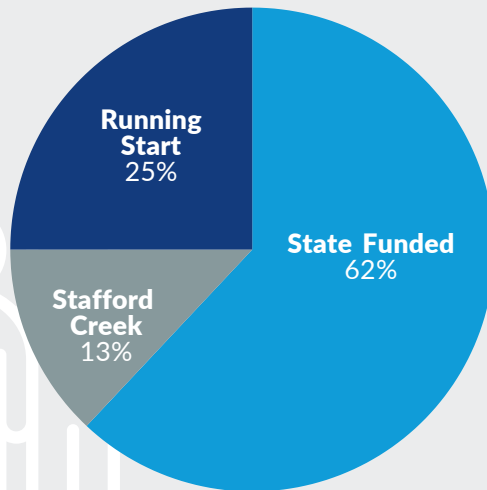
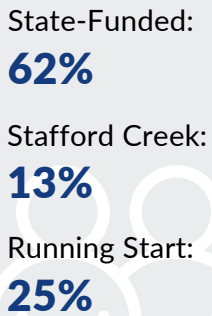
Breakdown of type of students from the 2,992 unique headcount from 2024-25.



FTE* by Course Modality^(b)

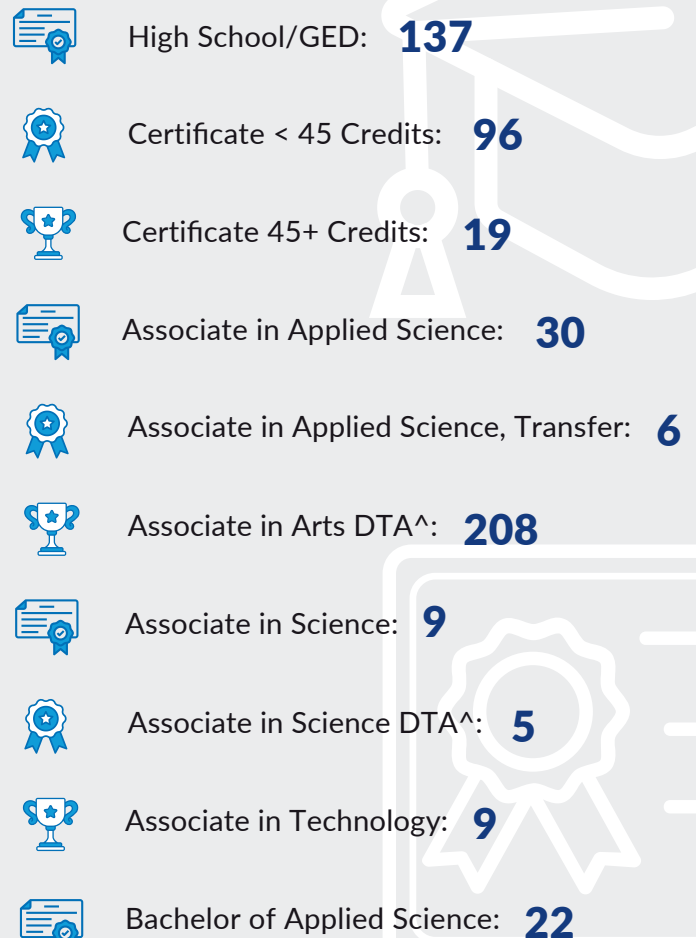


% FTE* Annual Breakout

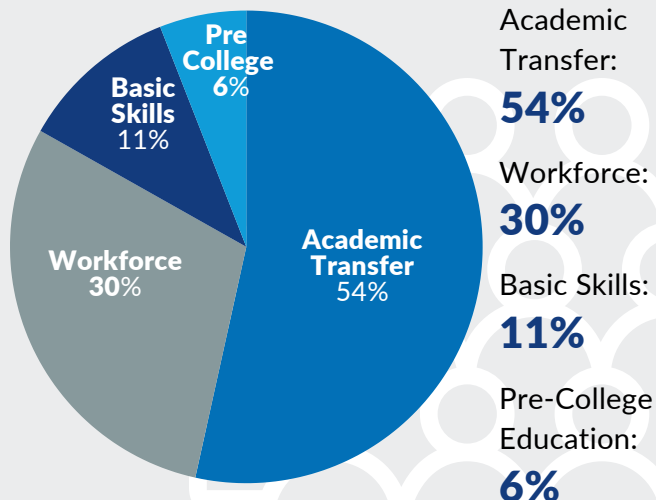
