Reports

President's Report:

President Humiston shared that he would be meeting with President Carli Schiffner later that day. No additional items were reported.

Executive Vice President's Report:

Lisa Getty reported serving on a tenure committee, completing a two-hour classroom observation, and attending a college council meeting. He noted plans to prepare an ASG report for an upcoming meeting.

VP for Community Engagement:

Michael Priest reported no updates at this time.

Athletics Senator:

Arisa Aburto provided updates on recent and upcoming athletic events, including basketball and baseball games. She also raised concerns regarding inappropriate/discriminatory speech and treatment issues within the athletics department and stated she is working with Student Life leadership to address the situation.

TRiO Senator:

Cristal Ramirez reported that TRiO is sending three students to the NWREC conference and thanked Student Life for funding the opportunity.

Performing Arts Senator:

Ross McCabre reported preparations for the winter musical Hello Dolly and requested volunteers for set painting and backstage support.

PTK Senator:

Annette Gerchak reported work on bylaws and meetings focused on increasing student engagement within the Beta Iota chapter.

Student Life Director:

Sarah Dalrymple shared the following:

- A proposal for establishing an Immediate Past President role would be voted on later in the meeting
- Student Life budgets with multiple options were completed and submitted for review
- She formally announced her resignation, with her last day on February 20, 2026
- She committed to prioritizing transition support and availability over the next two weeks

- She expressed appreciation and was grateful for the opportunity to serve ASGHC, the student leadership team, and GHC Students

New Business

1. Vote: Establishment of Immediate Past President Role

A motion was made to approve the creation of a paid Immediate Past President advisory role within ASGHC to be added to ASGHC Bylaws.

Voting Body: ASG Officers and Senators

Result: Passed with the required two-thirds majority

2. Vote: Esports Computer Lockers (Tech Fee Allocation)

A motion was made to approve funding for esports computer lockers using the tech fee in the amount of \$4,665 plus tax (over \$5,000 total).

Voting Body: Executive Officers

Result: Motion passed

Open Floor Discussion included:

- Student housing challenges, particularly laundry costs and safety concerns
- The anticipated increase in student athletes and related housing strain
- A recommendation to explore a homestay program for student athletes
- Agreement that the homestay concept is worth further exploration
